HBA Bass Tournament Rules

- 1. Tournament fees are \$150.00 per boat. Entry fee must be paid by Friday My 30, 2025 to guarantee an official tournament T-Shirt. Entries will still be accepted at the ramp but we can't guarantee t-shirt availability without advance reservation.
- 2. All entrants must wear a coast guard approved vest or preserver when the motor is pushing the boat.
- 3. Tournament scheduled rain or shine. If cancellation is necessary due to severe weather, tournament will be held on next available weekend.
- 4. All fishing must be done from a boat. Each boat can consist of no more than 2 people.
- 5. Each person is responsible for seeing all rules of safety and sportsmanship are followed even if the boat does not belong to them.
- 6. Only five (5) fish will be weighed whether you fish as a team or solo!
- 7. Fishing is permitted anywhere within the tournament waters, or connecting waters accessible by boat during specific times.
- 8. OFF LIMITS: There is no fishing within 50 yards of a gas pump, NO FISHING IN MOUNDWOOD CHANNEL FROM 368 BRIDGE TO MOUTH OF DUNN'S POND, the weigh-in area 15 minutes before the weigh-in starts and any area designated "no fishing" by the governing body of the lake.
- 9. Tournament is Bass only.
- 10. Only artificial lures will be permitted.
- 11. There is a ½ lb deduction penalty for dead fish
- 12. All fish must be lakes length. Indian Lake 12" (closed mouth). There will be a 1 lb deduction for short fish.
- 13. All live wells must be checked prior to putting your boat in the water.
- 14. Single file start will begin at 6:30 am following mandatory meeting at ramp. Each boat will receive a starting number based on their order of sign up and payment.
- 15. All participants must be checked in, with their boats in the water 15 minutes before launch for meeting on rules and regulations.
- 16. Participants must Check-In at the Weigh-In Station at time determined by Director at launch. A 1lb penalty will be issued for each minute late. Five minutes late will disqualify the team. No exceptions. There is no Check In Boat. You must check in at the Weigh-In Station.
- 17. Winners are determined by overall weight. Ties will split money evenly between teams for each place.
- 18. Each team member must have a valid Ohio fishing license.
- 19. Any occurrence not covered by the rules will be governed by tournament directors.
- 20. Any breach of the above rules will result in automatic disqualification. All interpretation of the above rules is subject to the Western Ohio Home Builders Association Bass Fishing Tournament Committee. All decisions by the committee are final.
- 21. Payback on top 10%. The more boats that are entered, the more places that are paid. 1st place is guaranteed \$2,500.
- 22. Big Bass is 100% payback per boat.
